The treatment of your animal will be performed under the direction of a veterinarian and our trained and qualified medical team. Despite the provisions of quality medical care, some animals may develop disease conditions or medical/surgical complications. In some cases, these conditions will require additional treatment raising the cost of health care above the estimate provided. Occasionally, complications may be so severe they result in patient death or extreme patient morbidity, sufficient to require euthanasia. While every reasonable effort to recognize and prevent these situations will be made, you should be aware that complications can and do occur. By your signature, you acknowledge and accept that certain expenses and risks do exist surrounding the diagnosis, care, and treatment of your animal as well as understand there are inherent risks associated with surgery and anesthesia. Complications are very rare, but possible. The Humane Society of Logan County and Green Prairie Animal Hospital are not responsible for any illness, or for the pet after spay and neuter. This includes kennel cough and canine influenza in dogs and upper respiratory infection in cats.
